This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website or engage with our services. - Social media platforms (if you connect with us via social media)

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

You can control your cookie preferences by adjusting your browser settings. However, disabling cookies may affect your ability to use certain features on our website.

7. Data Security

We are committed to protecting your personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, or alteration. We employ technical, administrative, and physical safeguards to ensure the security of your data. However, no data transmission over the Internet is 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. Your Rights and Choices

You have certain rights concerning your personal information, including:

b. Deletion

You may request the deletion of your personal information, subject to certain legal obligations.
